AD	Anno Domino - Latin for 'in the time of our Lord'. It means a date after Jesus was supposed to be born.
Aqueduct	A bridge like structure that carries water.
Centurion	Leader of a century.
Century	A division of the Roman army made up of 80 soldiers
Conquer	To take control by military force.
Emperor	A person who rules an empire
Empire	A group of countries ruled by one ruler.
Invasion	One country attacking another to take it over.
Iceni tribe	Tribe of eastern Britain during the Iron Age and early Roman era.
Latin	Language used by the Romans
Rebellion	Where people join together to fight against a person or group in charge.

Measurements They introduced miles, feet and inches.	Language Latin forms the roots of many of our words.	Names Months of the year and planets are Roman names.

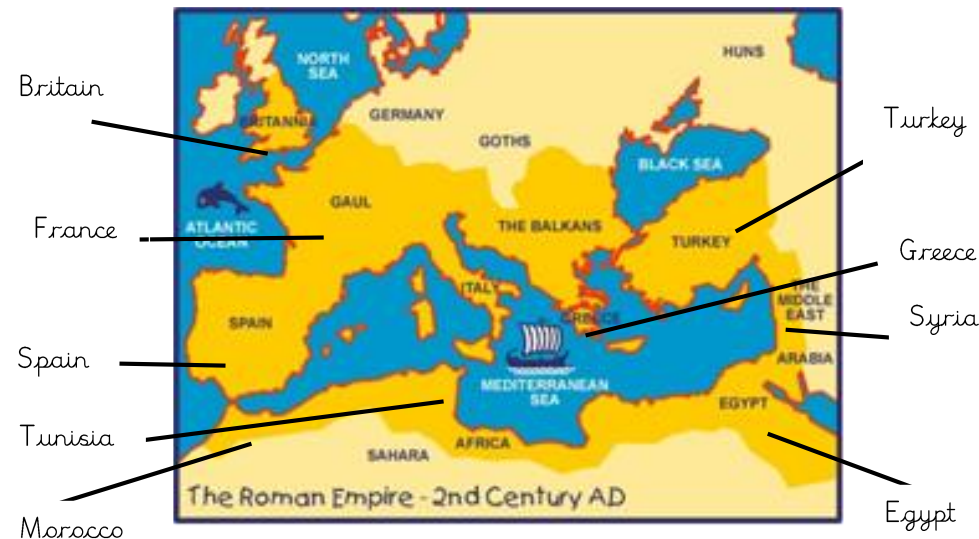
Key People

As it starts to fill

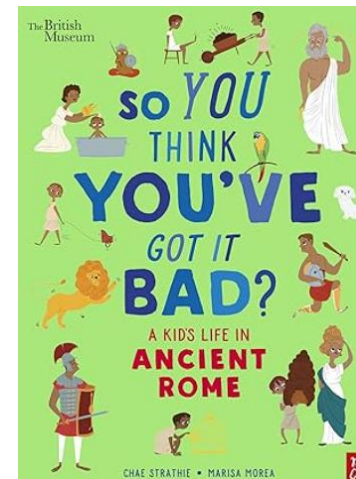
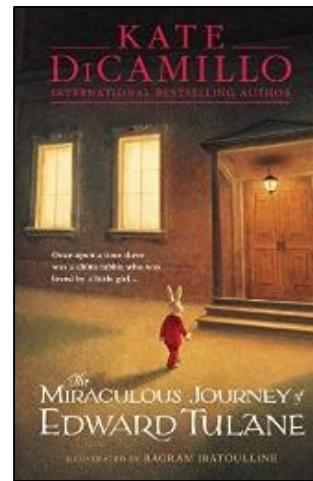
The drumming of the raindrops
